Code of Conduct

This code of conduct defines the expectations of Jr. Camp Counselor participants. The Jr. Camp Counselor program is designed to develop leadership skills for those that participate. Therefore participants will be held to a higher set of standards and inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated resulting in immediate removal from the program without a refund.

Expected Behavior:

1. I will have appropriate behavior and display a positive attitude at all times.
2. I will assist playground staff as directed and help organize activities for youth enrolled in day camp.
3. I will assist with general park duties. (ex. Trash pick-up, share coolers, Tower Lodge general cleaning)
4. I understand the Jr. Counselors will select a community service project and host events to raise money for our projects. I will actively participate in these events.
5. I will attend as many field trips as possible with the understanding that I will be responsible for assisting the staff with the campers.
6. I understand that if I don't display appropriate behavior my parents will be contacted and I will be removed from the program immediately.
7. I understand that after completing assigned task I must report to my Jr. Camp Counselor Supervisor or assigned supervisor for the day.
8. I understand the program is designed to teach job skills, leadership skills, the importance of community service, and also give me an opportunity to participate in field trips.
9. I will be a positive role model for the participants enrolled in day camp.
